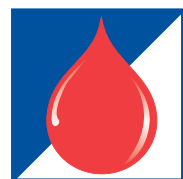

The Blood Alliance provides many opportunities for community volunteer service at our centers in Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina. Here are some examples of how you can generously donate your time as a volunteer:

- ♥ **Drawing Room Assistant** - Perform "Strip & Seal" procedures for donor product containers (minimum age 17, proof of Hepatitis B series vaccination, and parental consent form).
- ♥ **Blood Mobile Assistant** - Greeting donors, registration, providing refreshments during blood drives, etc.
- ♥ **Special Events, Health Fairs, & Special Projects** - Working with FGBA staff at community blood drives and donor events, assisting in preparation of promotional materials, greeting donors, registration, wearing the blood drop suit (our mascot), working the Pepsi Experience at all Jaguars home games, etc.
- ♥ **Office / Clerical** - Copying, promotional buttons, making posters, helping with bulk / mass mailings, etc.
- ♥ **Telerecruiting** - Includes making phone calls to thank donors for their donations or remind them of an upcoming appointment to donate.

All volunteers are required to attend a brief orientation before beginning service. Once completed, you may volunteer as much as your schedule allows.
